
# **Easter Egg Hunt**

# **Teacher Instructions:**

Use this Easter Egg Hunt activity with your students with all clues specially designed to work in a classroom setting.

- 1. Instruct the class on how to use the decoding page for the words in each clue.
- 2. Divide the class into at least 2 groups designated by the yellow or blue colour coded clues (version 1 and 2)
- 3. Make sure each clue (except the first one) is hidden in the class in the appropriate areas. be sure to hide the clues according to their "hiding spot" and not according to the answer.
- 4. Have an accompanying Easter egg (paper or real) at each clue location. Alternatively, you can have an easter egg at the end of the egg hunt for each student to have as their prize.
- 5. Use the answer page to help struggling teams get to the next destination.
- 6. Have fun and happy Easter!
